We all want to shine a light on the amazing things that young people are doing to make a difference. Bringing the Three Global Goals into your school or organisation provides an opportunity to do that with external support, global connectivity and access to materials, resources and examples that make this as effortless as possible for you.

Every project registered will automatically be nominated for one of our Global Youth Awards which are free to enter and can be individual, delivered by groups or as an entire school project. Enabling your young people to share their ideas and innovations to inspire other people around the world.

The Three Global Goal Projects and Awards have been created to provide opportunities for young people aged 11-17 to tap into creativity, imagination and play while delivering something that gives them a sense of pride and empowers them to make a difference in their local community.

They enable young people to step courageously into leadership action and to become inspiring role models for change. The Global Goal Projects can be delivered in alignment with the current curriculum or as extra curricular projects.

## THE GLOBAL YOUTH AWARDS

As an organisation we are striving to become pioneers for change by giving our young people not just a voice, but a platform to showcase their projects and inspire real change in the world. The Global Youth Awards is not just about celebrating the extraordinary achievements of our youth, it is more than that. It is about providing young people the opportunity to network with like minded individuals that can inspire, support and collaborate on projects as well as accessing incredible mentors that are already making headway to change the world.

Each of our winners will be invited to join the RoundTable Global Youth Ambassador team for a period of 12 months. They will be given access to the Shine Online Empowerment Programme for personal development and also the opportunity to be added to our online Global Talent Bank to harness support for future projects. We will provide additional mentoring and support to accelerate growth and overall group winners will be offered a free two day empowerment programme delivered by The RoundTable Global award winning leadership and development team.

## WHAT ARE THE THREE GLOBAL GOALS?

The Three Global Goals were inspired and created through ten global 'Finding Balance' Summits that we delivered in the UK, UAE, USA and Asia in 2017. Each Summit brought together 150 individuals from three generations to identify and find solutions for the major challenges we are currently facing.

Working with inspirational leaders in historic venues our immersive, experiential Summits captured the imagination of everyone who attended and forged cross generational collaborations for change. Overwhelmingly, regardless of culture and generation, the consensus was that if we focus our collective global energies on education, empowerment and the environment, we can change the world.

This was the start of the Three Global Goals which we then decided to incorporate into absolutely everything that we do. More details on what we mean by these goals is below and we are keen to help you to identify what they mean to you and your young people and how you can align them with your strategic objectives.

### 1.Educational Innovation

The current education system has been in place for 200 years. Although powerful, like everything else in life, it needs to continuously evolve to be able to provide the mindset, knowledge and development for the next generation to thrive. The Educational Innovation Goal is an opportunity to find out from our young people, their ideas on providing innovative additional learning opportunities to the current curriculum as well as different styles of leading and teaching. This goal recognises that every single person on this planet is a unique individual with different passions and learning styles. It is an attempt to authentically unlock potential and create a learning community that works for everyone. It also provides an opportunity to transcend current educational issues and labels such as bullying, mental health, gender confusion and sexual orientation.

## 2. Empowering Everyone

We live in a global society that is constantly dividing us by what we have, know, believe in and where we live. The Empowering Everyone goal is a focus on providing equal, inclusive access to knowledge, materials, personal development and opportunities to everyone regardless of gender, ethnicity, faith, age, ability, orientation or location. It has been created in the understanding that we are all one tribe of humans and we exist on this planet to connect, learn and share. Empowering Everyone to take 100% responsibility for what they are creating on a daily basis and enabling them to create opportunities to contribute to change.

## 3. Environmental Rejuvenation

The world is changing at an exponential rate and if we want to continue to exist on this planet we need to go Beyond Sustainability and focus on restoring and rejuvenating the global eco-system. The Environmental Rejuvenation goal intends to create awareness of the environmental impact we are having as a species and inspire everyone to take individual and collective action. Conscious consumerism, choices in what we eat and care-taking for the other living organisms and species on this planet are all important focuses for this goal. It is our responsibility to ensure that future generations can not only survive but thrive.


#### INNOVATION


#### CHANGE




